# LEG 1 / MELBOURNE TO WODONGA

3 HOURS & 21 MINUTES / 321KM

Wodonga lies on the Victorian border of NSW and features Gateway Island, on Murray River and Wodonga Creek. Enjoy art galleries, souvenir and craft outlets, a theatre, the old Customs House and walking trails throughout the surrounding parkland and beside the river. Also, within a short drive are several regional attractions including the wineries of Rutherglen and the historic towns of Chiltern, Beechworth and Yackandandah. For a longer scenic drive, follow the Murray Valley Highway eastwards out to Corryong or take the longer route via the Murray River Road which follows the river along its natural and picturesque upper reaches.

Visit Racecourse Beach in Ulladulla, a long surf beach (accessed from the car park), and enjoy the lookout on South Pacific Crescent. The elevated car park is also a good spot for whale watching. At low tide and in small swell explore the rock platform on the northern end of the beach. Whilst in the area enjoy the Ulladulla Harbour Markets (crafts, produce, specialty), run by the volunteer members on the second Sunday of each month. The nearby town of Milton offers arts and Cupitt's outdoor wine tasting experience overlooking the vineyard and rolling hills of Milton.

# LEG 1 / CAIRNS TO MISSION BEACH

1 HOUR & 52 MINUTES / 139KM

This quiet stretch of the Tropical North Queensland coast is the closest point to the Great Barrier Reef on the mainland. Surrounded by lush rainforest, the laid-back beachside village of Mission Beach is the perfect place to relax and unwind. With 14km of white sandy beaches to stroll and the vibrant art culture of the village you find something for everyone. For the adventure junkies, Mission Beach is the access point to white-water rafting down the Tully River (about 50km inland), and skydiving opportunities over the reef and rainforest. Bird lovers will enjoy the chance to spot a Cassowary (Australian endangered flightless bird). And nature lovers will enjoy the 26km Cardwell Forest Drive loops through the Girringun National Park, known for its spectacular waterfalls and secluded swimming holes (including the Spa Pool, a rock pool with a natural depression that causes the water to bubble like a jacuzzi). Note: October to June, dangerous marine stingers (including box jellyfish) are found in the ocean off Mission Beach. During this time, swim only within netted areas.
